"The Young Americans" is a non profit organisation, founded in 1962 to reflect a positive and honest image of America's youth through music and dance. Cast members range in age from 17 to 25 and they tour the world to promote mutual understanding through educational initiatives and theatrical performances. This spring we will welcome a cast selected from around 300 Young Americans."

About the Program

In the 1990s arts courses started disappearing from the curriculum in many schools across the US due to educational cuts. In response to this, The Young Americans started this unique outreach program, taking a workshop to schools during which they produce an hour long musical show over the course of 3 days. Over the years, this educational program has gained in popularity not only in the States, but all over the world, and to date about 850,000 kids in 31 countries have participated in the workshop, including more than 140,000 in Japan.

# Global Workshop in Iwakuni

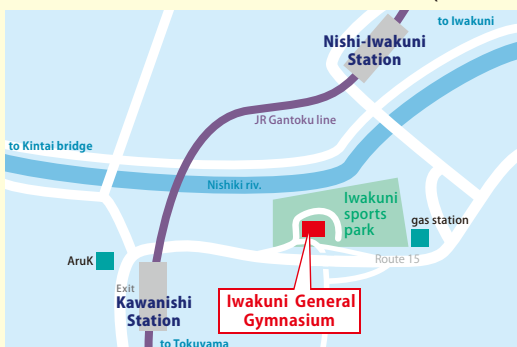
